

Environmental Policy of J. Allcock & Sons Ltd

It is the policy of J. Allcock & Sons Ltd. Wellington Rubber Company Ltd. and Remould Ltd. to use its technical know how and specialised equipment to help companies with problems of recycling cured rubber by-products from their operations. By utilising our facilities, this material can be processed such that it may be reused, either back into the original stream, or into alternative outlets, and hence not consigned to landfill. To this end we have gained and maintain exemption reference AF0002FE from The Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2010. Registration of exempt activities- Use of Waste to Manufacture Finished Goods (Non-Agricultural Waste only)

It is also our policy to ensure that our specialised equipment is operated as efficiently and as safely as possible. To this end additional controls have been added to ensure that the energy used is monitored, and the load on each machine is limited. Cooling water is recycled, and pneumatic conveying systems are operated in such a way as to ensure that any leakage will not generate dust, and cross contamination. An efficient bag filter system ensures that any remnants are not released to atmosphere. Rubber fume can be controlled by the use of Electrostatic Precipitation equipment built into the system.

All other aspects of the storage, distribution and transportation of our complete range of products are considered, and controlled so as to produce minimum impact on the environment.
