Technical Data Sheet [Mechanical Rubber Granules]



Introduction:

This is produced by the ambient grinding of vulcanised Mechanical rubber waste / scrap. The term "mechanical" is usually taken to mean general purpose, non-specification, low cost rubber products. This means that the general properties may be more variable than with other rubber Granules.

Uses:

It could be used in low cost, non-specified compounds, and could be used in much higher concentrations than with higher specification materials. It may have less effect on density than with high levels of mineral fillers.

Typical Characteristics:

It is supplied as a dry, granule.

Application/ How to Use:

Use as you would use any other rubber granule. Note that you can use much higher concentrations than you would use with say, tyre tread granule

Shelf Life:

If protected from heat and light it will last almost indefinitely, but it is usual to quote two years.

Packaging:

Usually packed in 25kg bags, stacked 40 to a pallet. It may be possible to supply in other sizes.
